**ORDINANCE 23-03**

**AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING THE PLACEMENT OR STORAGE OF CAMPERS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, BOATS, AND TRAILERS WHICH ARE USED INTERMITTENTLY AND LOCATED UPON REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MALTA** was presented to Council. Joe Williams made a motion to move Ordinance 23-03 to the third reading, seconded by Jamie White. Roll call vote, all yeas.

**ORDINANCE 23-17**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS INSIDE THE VILLAGE OF MALTA AND PENALITIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS OF SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS** was presented to Council. Jamie White made a motion to move Ordinance 23-17 to the third reading, seconded by Joe Williams. Roll call vote, all yeas.

**Bill Smith, Village Administrator gave the following report:**

- \* The Kayak Ramp and boat docks have been removed and are in storage.
- \* Need to find a better way to keep barrels under the docks, straps that presently used do not work very well.
- \* Having problems with grease in the lift station pumps. The grease sets up and jams the pumps. The crew is getting very good at pulling the pumps and cleaning them, but need to find out where the grease is coming from and get it corrected.
- \* Jack O Lantern Jamboree update: Things are looking good for a great event. Trying to get the mayors from the villages to ride on a float for the parade. There are lots of events scheduled for the kids, and there is plenty of room for vendors.

- \* Thanked the crew for the quick response to clean up the fallen tree in the river.


**Council Member, Scott Moore:**
