ORDINANCE 21-17

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF CROWN WOOD CIRCLE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Malta pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 723.04, has the authority to change the name, vacating, or narrowing streets on petition. ... The legislative authority may include in one ordinance the change of name, vacating, or narrowing of more than one street, avenue, or alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Malta, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section I: WHEREAS, Council has determined that a portion of a certain alley/street located in the Village is no longer necessary for public use and as such is desirous of vacating the same, reserving the right for an easement for public utilities; and

Section II: WHEREAS, NOTICE OF INTENT TO VACATE A PROPORTION OF A VILLAGE STREET KNOWN AS: CROWN WOOD CIRCLE DRIVE IN CROWN WOOD CIRCLE SUDIVISION (PB-C, PAGE- 46) SECTION 10, RANGE NO. 12, TOWNSHIP NO 10 MALTA TWP, IN THE VILLAGE OF MALTA, OHIO.

Section III: That this Ordinance 21-17 shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
