LIMITS AND IS DESIGNED TO LIMIT NUISANCES AND PREVENT UNSANITARY OR
UNSAFE CONDITIONS. THIS ORDINANCE ALSO PROHIBITS THE RAISING, KEEPING,
MAINTAINING, OR HABORING OF LIVESTOCK OR OTHER FOWL, EXCLUDING CHICKENS
(LAYING HENS) WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS was presented to Council. Homer Weekley
