The Village of Malta Council convened in REGULAR session at 5:30 p.m. in the Malta Village Council Chambers. Mayor, Terry McGrath called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

**The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor, Terry McGrath.**

The minutes from the previous regular meeting were approved on a motion made by Homer Weekley, seconded by Devan Vincent. Roll call vote, 2 yeas, (Homer and Don), and 2 abstains (Jamie and Devan).

The bills were approved to be paid out of respective funds on a motion made by Don Larrick, seconded by Devan Vincent. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Motion made by Homer Weekley and seconded by Devan Vincent to excuse Leslie Robbins and Scott Moore. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Resolution 25-40 was read by Mayor McGrath and a motion to approve was made by Don Larrick and seconded by Jamie White to approve. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Resolution 25-42 was read by Mayor McGrath and a motion to approve was made by Jamie White and seconded by Don Larrick to approve. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Resolution 25-43 was read by Mayor McGrath and a motion to approve was made by Don Larrick and seconded by Devan Vincent. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Ordinance 25-39 was read by Mayor McGrath and a motion to adopt was made by Homer Weekley and seconded by Jamie White. Roll call vote, all yeas.

## **Mayor's Report**

Land-bank personnel reported that they have petitioned the court to have the abandoned house at 621 N. Main Street demolished.

The next regularly scheduled council meeting was set to fall on January 1, 2026. A motion was made by Jamie White and seconded by Don Larrick to cancel the meeting scheduled for January 1. Roll call vote, all yeas.

## **Administrator's Report – Bill Smith**

- Road salt order update: 50 tons were ordered, and 40 tons have been received.
- During the snow event on the weekend of December 12, the street crew worked diligently to keep village streets clear and assisted in pulling three vehicles out of the snow on Malta Hill.
- A former employee was utilized to assist with snow-plow operations.

There was council discussion regarding insurance liability issues. Jamie White and Homer Weekley noted that, considering the experience of current employees, it was wise to utilize Corey. Due to liability concerns, the council determined that a check should be made to ensure Corey is on the insurance policy; if not, he should be added.

- Twelve applications have been received for the open street crew position. A finance committee meeting and an emergency council meeting will be scheduled for 5:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m., respectively, on December 30 to discuss and approve the hiring of a new crew member.

### **Homer Weekley**


- Inquired about the cost the village pays for audits.
- Wished everyone present a Merry Christmas.


### **Don Larrick**

- Charlie Edelblut reports that the people that were reported to have “moved out in the middle of the night” across the street are still living there and they are still taking up all available parking spaces with vehicles that have either no tags or temporary tags that expired years ago. We have an ordinance on the books that cover the situation, and we need to come up with a solution to the problem.
- There is an old camping trailer parked behind 641 N. Main Street, the occupant states that he doesn't know who it belongs to or how it got there. It is also possible that homeless people are staying in the camper. Once again we need to provide a solution.
- Bill Campbell has had gasoline stolen from two vehicles parked behind his home.
