

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Village of Malta intends to contract engineering and surveying services in connection with a water treatment plant upgrade, water meters, and possible expansion. Professional Engineering Services needed include design, contract administration and observation, surveying, and permitting assistance. The WTP upgrades may include increasing capacity, softening, filter upgrades, new water well, and water meter for Malta Village. The 1999 WTP supplies water to McConnelsville and Morgan-Meigsville Water District with approximately 2,000 customers in total. The consultant shall be familiar with the Village of Malta's rules and regulations for water.

It is the intent of the Village to solicit statements of qualifications from firms interested in providing such services. Statements of qualifications should include information regarding the firm's history; education and experience of owners and key technical personnel; technical expertise of the firm's current staff; experience in designing similar projects; proximity to project site; availability of staff; the firm's equipment and facilities; references, and any previous work performed for the Village of Malta.

Upon receipt of statements of qualifications, it is the intent of the Village to prepare a list of prequalified firms to provide engineering and surveying services. Evaluation of firms for inclusion on the prequalified list and notification and evaluation of prequalified firms for specific projects will be as required by Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.67-71. Malta will enter into contract negotiations with the most highly qualified firm for the project. Firms interested in work should provide their statements by 4:00pm on August 31, 2026.
