Malta State of the Village Address was given by Mayor, Terry McGrath.

The visitors were present to discuss the conditions of the roads and drainage systems where they live within the village. Concerns for the rate difference in water, (Meigs vs Malta) upset about paying village taxes and doesn't see any benefits to what tax money is used for. There was interest in being on village council. Terry is having a street and finance committee review these concerns.

Mayor plans to take names of interested parties in the vacant council seat until January 31, 2026.

- * Village does salt & plow on Crownwood Circle.


Council Member, Homer Weekley:


- * Asked about January activity for America250. January didn't have anything planned.
