## **CEMETERY RESOLUTION 20-09**

## AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE ATHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE PEOPLE INSUFFICIENT AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR A LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the Village of Malta and the Trustees of the Township of Malta, that the amount of taxes which may be raised by law without a vote of the electors is insufficient to run the Malta Union Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Council of the Village of Malta and the Trustees of the Township of Malta to submit the question of a levy to a vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exits affecting the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Malta and the residents of the Township of Malta.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, by the Council of the Village of Malta, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, and the Township Trustees of the Township of Malta, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, in Joint session assembled, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members elected thereto concurring as follows:

Section I: That the maximum amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes at the maximum rate authorized by Section 5705.02 and Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code on all taxable property in said Township and Village, will be insufficient to provide adequate care of the Malta Union Cemetery, which is under the joint supervision of said Village and Township; and that to maintain said cemetery, taxes must be levied upon the taxable property of said Village and Township for a period of five (5) years at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by law.

Section II: That it is necessary to renew the existing tax levy for a period of five (5) years, beginning with tax year 2021 and continuing for the years 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025 at the rate of 1.0 mills on each dollar of tax evaluation or ten cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable property within the Village and Township of Malta.

Section III: That the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to Deputy State Supervisors and Inspectors of Election of Morgan County, Ohio, in order that said Supervisors and Inspectors of Elections may make necessary arrangements for the submission of such questions to the electors of said Village and Township as provided by law.

Section IV: That the Mayor of the Village of Malta and Chairman of the Malta Township Trustees be, and are hereby declared to cause such notice of such election to be published as required by law.
