RESOLUTION 22-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND /OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Malta is planning to make capital improvements to Furnace Street (5th Street West to Dead End), Mill Street (Main Street South 620 Feet). Both Streets are to be milled and paved.

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Malta, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above

SECTION 2. The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into an agreement with the County Engineer as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
