VILLAGE OF MALTA**


WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Malta has determined that is necessary to appoint a Councilman to replace Devan Vincent.

ORDINANCE 26-01


AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Malta, State of Ohio, that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Village, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026, the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:

1. That there be appropriated in the HB168/ARPA GRANT, line item 5705-411-0000 the sum of \$41,732.86, HB168/ARPA GRANT.
2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized appropriate and transfer fund from the foregoing appropriations upon approval by the Village Council, who are authorized by law to approve same.
3. That this Ordinance shall be deemed an emergency measure, effective upon passage.

REGULAR SESSION

Held: February 05, 2026

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The Village of Malta Council convened in REGULAR session at 6:00 p.m. in the Malta Village Council Chambers. Mayor, Terry McGrath called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

Invocation: The Invocation was given by Jamie White.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor, Terry McGrath.

The minutes from the previous regular meeting were approved on a motion made by Leslie Robbins, seconded by Homer Weekley. Leslie Robbins. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The minutes from the previous Special meeting, were approved on a motion made by Leslie Robbins, seconded by Homer Weekley. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The bills were approved to be paid out of respective funds on a motion made by Jamie White, seconded by Don Larrick. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The Mayor's Report was read by Mayor, Terry McGrath.

A motion to accept the Mayor's Report was made by Don Larrick, seconded by Jamie White. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Bill Smith, Village Administrator:

- * Tree grant was not awarded to Malta, it was awarded to other villages that had previously been awarded the grant, to help finish their next phases.
- * Spent time trying to unfreeze lines on Spring Street. The line isn't deep enough in the ground to keep it from freezing. Echo Street still needed worked on and 2 of those lines were frozen at the meter. Been using heaters in the meter pits.
- * Village dropped of cases of water to the homes that had no water due to the freeze.
- * Met with DLZ and Shannon Wells on a couple of projects the village would like to do.
- * One project will consist of a paved walking/bike trail. Sidewalk replacements and repairs. Paving from Front Street from North Valley Bank to Mill and Main Streets, roundabout and 4th & 5th Street down 9th Street, Main Street to 11th Street. Project also has drainage at Goins Park. Project to start Fall 2026.
- * The second project is Front Street (Bridge to village limits) drainage, paving and curbs. Drainage placement by old railroad bed to divert water, catch basin by old bait shop. Projected start date is also Fall 2026.
- * Well #7 does have to be raised 11 feet. 2 quotes have been given. One quote was over \$11,000.00 and the other is under \$14,000.00. We still have \$10,000.00 left in our EPA grant to go toward this project.
- * Still have a lot of work to do on the water treatment plant project. The plant is not in terrible shape for as old as it is. The way funding will work will be in sections so the plant isn't completely shut down for repairs.
- * Sewer laterals have been pushed back.
- * Village has purchased the bucket truck discussed in previous meeting.
- * Going to spend the first hour of Friday Morning salting roads for incoming snow.


Council President, Leslie Robbins:

* Mentioned the employees did a great job cleaning streets, asks that they keep hydrants uncovered and clear from snow.

Council Member, Jamie White:

* Appreciates the effort of the employees to thaw the frozen water lines.

With no further business to bring before Council the meeting was adjourned at 6:38 P.M. on a motion made by Don Larrick.
